GETTING HERE

Beverley Festival of Christmas is located in Beverley town centre, only a short walk from the train/bus station and various car parks. On Sunday 8th December there will be a number of road closures and restricted parking within Beverley town centre, please visit our website for full details.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT:

FREE Park & Ride - HU17 8QZ

Parking for 500 cars. The Park & Ride will operate from Beverley Racecourse and Wylies Road near North Bar. Two buses will run every 10-15 minutes. The first bus will leave at 9am and the last bus will leave at 5pm.

FREE Coach Parking - HU17 9AW

Available in School Lane Car & Coach Park, 3 minutes walk to the town centre. Please pre book your space by emailing **transport.support@eastriding.gov.uk**

Beverley Train Station - HU17 OAS

Located in Station Square, 5 minutes walk to the town centre. Close to Flemingate Shopping Centre and Beverley Minster.

Beverley Bus Station – HU17 8BQ

Located in Sow Hill Road, 1 minute walk to the town centre. Service into Beverley from all over the region.
